Franco-Gabonese self-made entrepreneur Nicolas Pompigne-Mognard is the Founder, Chairman and 100% owner of APO Group, the leading communications and business consultancy in Africa.

Nicolas created APO Group in 2007 while he was a journalist for online Gabonese media Gabonews and Deputy President of the Panafrican Press Organization in France (APPA – Association de la Presse Panafricaine). He founded the company with savings of €10,000 used as start-up capital. The objective was to provide international and African media with access to reliable news about the continent's economy, businesses, and investment. Since then, APO Group has helped communicators relay compelling, uniquely African stories to diverse audiences, driving a change in the African narrative to a more positive point of view.
